

St. Vincent's Academy Summer School Options

Students must meet with the Academic Dean, before registering for ANY summer school classes. Students are only allowed to makeup 2 credits in summer school credit recovery. If a student fails 3 courses, they may not return to St. Vincent's Academy.

The GA DOE Credit Recovery Program provides students, who did not initially succeed in obtaining course credit, with the opportunity to retake a course to earn credit towards graduation.

- Credit Recovery courses have flexible schedules and are not facilitated by a teacher.
- The Credit Recovery Program allows students, who have completed seat time and calendar requirements, to earn credit based on competency of the content standards.
- Credit Recovery courses are complete courses, aligned to state standards, for which the student will demonstrate mastery before receiving a grade.
- The Credit Recovery Program offers core courses, and limited electives
- The Georgia Credit Recovery Program is also available to Georgia private high school students for a fee. All enrollments are \$100 per 1/2 credit.
- Students are required to create a credit recovery account before approval by the SVA Academic Dean
- Credit Recovery Course(s) MUST be completed before the start of the 2018-2019 school year if choosing GA Virtual School Credit Recovery

The Keystone School's credit recovery program is designed for students who have failed a previous attempt at a course. Credit recovery units are not intended as original credit and do not re-teach content for an entire course. Online student enrolled in either part A or part B must spend a minimum of four weeks and a maximum of eight weeks completing their course. A transcript of the credit recovery grade must be sent to St. Vincent's Academy (attn: Mary Gene Sikes).
